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1. Einleitung

Das EuBP-Datentool wird im Verfahren EuBP (Elektronisch unterstützte Betriebsprüfung) eingesetzt.

Es handelt sich dabei um eine Java Standalone-Anwendung, welche auf Basis von XML-Schemadateien Validierungen auf ausgewählte Eingangsdateien durchführt.

Darüber hinaus wird der Inhalt der Datei in einem benutzerfreundlichen Format visualisiert.

Ziel dieses Dokumentes ist es einen groben Überblick über die Funktionsweise des EuBP-Datentools zu geben.

3. Installation

3.1 Systemvoraussetzungen

Das EuBP-Datentool wurde mit Java SE in der Version 8 implementiert. Voraussetzung ist also eine JRE Version 8 oder höher.

3.2 Ablageort

Wie schon unter Punkt 2 beschrieben wird das EuBP-Datentool in einer 7Z-Datei geliefert. Diese ist in einem lokalen Ordner zu entpacken, das EuBP-Datentool erfordert ansonsten keine weitere Installation. Zu beachten sind hierbei aber mehrere Punkte:

- Die ebenfalls beigelegten XML-Schemadateien müssen im gleichen Ordner liegen wie die EXE-Datei und dürfen nicht umbenannt werden.
- Das EuBP-Datentool sollte **nicht** auf einem Netzlaufwerk abgelegt und von dort ausgeführt werden, da dies zu massiven Verlangsamungen des Programms führen kann. Für eine optimale Funktionsweise **muss** die Anwendung auf einem lokalen Laufwerk abgelegt werden.

4. Schemavalidierung der Eingangsdatei

Beim EuBP-Datentool werden standardmäßig die Datensätze validiert. Es wird davon ausgegangen, dass nach der Validierung der Datensatz syntaktisch korrekt ist. Bei einem Fehler im Aufbau des Datensatzes wird durch die Schemavalidierung ein Fehler nach der Datensatzbeschreibung² ausgegeben.

Ist der Datensatz nicht schemakonform, kann es dazu kommen, dass die Datei nicht korrekt angezeigt werden kann. Standardmäßig wird die Datei bei einem Fehler nicht angezeigt. Dies kann jedoch zum Zwecke der Fehlersuche über ein Kontrollkästchen („Checkbox“) aktiviert werden. Es kann dann jedoch nicht gewährleistet werden, dass die Anzeige fachlich korrekt ist.

Die Versionsnummer des EuBP-Datentools setzt sich aus den folgenden Bestandteilen zusammen:

Jahr.Quartal.Hauptversionsnummer.Nebenversionsnummer

Beispiel: **2022.3.1.0**

Jahr: Aktuelles Jahr der Veröffentlichung

Quartal: Aktuelles Quartal der Veröffentlichung

Hauptversionsnummer: Diese Ziffer wird bei neuem Release pro Quartal hochgezählt.

Nebenversionsnummer: Diese Ziffer wird bei kleineren Änderungen fachlicher und technischer Natur sowie Bugfixes inkrementiert.
